Dear Parents and members of the School Community,

It takes a village ...

We are lucky to live in the community we do. We share the same values of respect and responsibility which is one of the reasons we have very little vandalism in our community spaces. We all work together to care for everyone in our community and especially in the care and growth of the children.

As is often the case in Term One, with the return to school and warm weather, I am noticing more children using the playground areas out of school hours. I need to remind everyone that while our school is used by the community, the responsibility for safety of equipment and people lies with Department of Education employees and, specifically with the Principal.

While our school grounds appear to be an open community space, I need to remind the adults in our community that children should not be playing in the grounds without adult supervision at any time. During the school day the teachers provide supervision, as they are legally required to do. Out of school hours if you want to make use of the playground spaces you need to provide adult supervision for your children.

The Shire Council provide a community play area in the park behind the Maternal Health building.

I do not want us to be like most urban schools where the gates are locked and no access is allowed out of school hours. It is lovely to see past students visit with their families or travelers stopping for a break sharing our facilities. However, I encourage our community to continue to work together to ensure that our children play safely.

They made the improvements and tested the maze again. We then had a group discussion about how using the reflection sheet helped us with our thinking.
